

Biaggio Signorelli, founder of the Doltone House Group, was an extraordinary man. His world changed when he was diagnosed with Mesothelioma in October 2007 and died on 30 May 2008.

It took some time to detect the type of Cancer, which was followed by chemotherapy. The aim was to increase his life expectancy, however this was never going to cure him. While being treated, Biaggio became acquainted with Keith Cox (now Board Member), nurse practitioner in the oncology chemotherapy unit at Sydney's Royal Prince Alfred Hospital, along with Associate Professor Michael Boyer, Director of the Sydney Cancer Centre. These people had a huge impact on Biaggio's physical and mental wellbeing.

Then came his final journey to the palliative care unit at Calvary Hospital - the final two weeks of his life. His son Paul, did not leave his side and nursed Biaggio in his final hours. A very strong bond between father and son indeed.

Up until the mid-1980s, Australia had one of the highest rates of asbestos use per person in the world.



The average life expectancy from diagnosis of Mesothelioma to death is just nine months.



Approximately one third of all homes in Australia contain asbestos products. If your house was built before 1990, it is likely that it will contain asbestos in some form.



In Australian households, asbestos can be found in roofing, flooring, guttering, electricals, wall sheeting, fencing, putty and glues.



Asbestos becomes a danger to your health when it is damaged, weathered or disturbed, such as through renovating. Inhaling asbestos fibres can result in the development of Mesothelioma.



Australia has the highest incidence of malignant Mesothelioma per capita in the world.



There is currently no cure for Mesothelioma. This is why we need your help to end asbestos cancer.




Mark Vincent
